

REGULAR MEETING, TUESDAY, APRIL 28, 2020 7:00 P.M.-TOWN HALL

The Regular meeting of the Town of Buffalo Board was called to order by Chairman Steve James. Roll call: Semling, Waters, Strom, Bittner. Citizens: Bob Baures, Mary Ann McMillen. The meeting was held as noticed. Motion Semling, second Waters to approve minutes from March 24, 2020 Regular Meeting. All yes, motion carried.

Treasurer's Report: Balance as of April 28, 2020 is \$13,586.95. Lottery Credit was received of \$2,657.32, Transportation Aid of \$18,455.13. CAPX will be here in May of \$71788 and Refuge of \$6870. Delinquent Personal Property Taxes still owed \$282.73. Postponed until July 31, 2020 Personal Property Taxes owed \$685.90. Liquor Licenses will be sent out in May. Fund Balance was read. Bills were read. Motion Waters, second Semling to accept treasurer's report and pay bills. All yes, motion carried.

Chair: Open Book will be held May 12, 2020 from 3:00 pm to 6:00 pm. Board of Review will be held May 19, 2020 from 6:00pm to 8:00 pm. Waters is Chair with Semling, James and Strom as members and Bittner as alternate. Annual meeting was postponed from April 14, 2020 to May 12, 2020 at 7:00 pm. Motion Waters, second Semling to sign permit for Century Link to work on Platte's Valley, Buffalo Ridge and Pieper's Valley. All yes, motion carried. WI Department of Transportation will make new sign for Bluff Siding that was removed by the Flyway Bike Trail. New address at the Winona Boat Club is W491 Aghaming Park Road. Discussion of the Act 185. Consensus of the Board is to not delay tax payments. Scoreboard has been placed and needs some electrical work done yet. Waiting until May 26, 2020 when the Stay at home order has been lifted to open Restrooms in Park. Manhole covers have been sand blasted and replaced. Restroom doors need to be painted. With Alliance Bank having closed doors, we are not able to post notices. For now, place notice at the Recycling Center until Alliance Bank opens doors to public again. Audit was received and needs to be gone over by Chair and Clerk. Contract is up and needs new one. Received signs for Palubicki Drive. At this time the road is not a Town Road. When another lot has been sold, then the road needs to be up to specks before new lot owner can build by Palubicki. Motion Semling, second Waters to sign the Amended Resolution to postpone the Sandmine loan to be repaid in 2021, 2022 and 2023. All yes, motion carried.

1st Supervisor: Town Hall Rental: all rentals in May have been cancelled. Purchased toilet paper for the Park restrooms. Need checks for the floor in the kitchen. Only 33% return rate for Census. Recycling Center has been very busy and Gordie is doing a wonderful job.

2nd Supervisor: Baures' bill was gone over. End of snowplowing, sweeping, arm mowed Pieper's Valley, cold mix patching, removed brush. Hwy 93 to be resurfaced so blacktop plant will be stationed in Arcadia. Need to pave County Road P by County. Pieper's Valley needs patch resurfacing. Thomas Road issue has not been resolved. Jumbeck Road has some swelling. Needs gravel on whole .9-mile road. Need to crack seal Cole Bluff Road. Road Review will be held May 14, 2020 at 4:30 pm at the Town Hall. Hwy Department has new milling machine. Use for Platte's Valley Road. Sealcoating Pieper's Valley. Total projects \$45,000 for 3 plus miles.

Clerk: Election went well. Everyone was very happy how things were set up. Next Election is August 11, 2020 for Partisan Primary and General Election/Presidential to be held November 3, 2020. Liquor Licenses to be sent out in May. Dog licenses were due March 31, 2020. Still receiving a few. Humane Society is wanting \$11 per cat that is turned into them. Website wants to upgrade. No numbers were given. Peachtree is not working on new computer. Outdated system, Sage wants around \$1000/yr. for upgrades.

McMillen announced the Public Health Department will be offering free COVID-19 tests at the Pepin/Buffalo County Hwy Department.
