

REGULAR MEETING, TUESDAY, MAY 24, 2022 7:00 P.M.-TOWN HALL

The Regular meeting of the Town of Buffalo Board was called to order by Chairman Steve James. Roll call: Draskowski, Waters, Bittner, Strom. Citizens: Bob Baures. The meeting was held as noticed. Motion Waters, second Draskowski to approve minutes from April 26, 2022 Regular Meeting. All yes, motion carried.

Treasurer's Report: Balance of April 3, 2022: \$21,223.04. Balance as of April 23, 2022: \$89,506.15. Transportation Aid received of \$18,726.78. CAPX received of \$71,788. Personal Property Aid \$424.37 and invoice for Polzer \$1062.00 was received. Liquor Licenses are due in June. Transferred \$5000 to savings account. Financial Statement gone over. Bills were read. Motion Draskowski, second Waters to accept treasurer's report and pay bills. All yes, motion carried.

Chair: Announcements: Hwy 35/54 will be closed by the railroad tracks estimated time of July 5-July 19. Flag was destroyed by wind. Terr Duellman helped replace the flag. MFL resolution language is in question. Change is necessary. Waiting for County. Board of Review is postponed to June 14, 2022 from 6-8 pm. Open Book is set for June 7, 2022 from 3-6pm. Letters were sent out in regards to traffic ordinance violations on Spur Lane. Some have moved the items. It is a safety hazard. Unregistered vehicles parked on right of way is a violation also. Given until June 1, 2022 to be moved. Silver Street turn around has garage on it. Scharlau would like to stake out where turn around would be best. Schaffner Plumbing opened park pressure tank. Bladder is shot on tank and needs to be replaced. It is up and open now. Park bleachers are in need of some attention. Seats need to be flipped to help last a couple more years. Metal bleachers need to be power washed. ARPA report has been accepted. Waiting to hear work back on the grant for Broadband end of June beginning of July. Next meeting is set for June 21, 2022 at 630 pm. Motion Waters, second Draskowski to grant permission for Chair to speak to attorney for process of loan and to use ARPA money for Towns portion for Broadband. All yes, motion carried. Street Safety for All (SS4A) is a Federal Infrastructure Bill. Webinar to be held June 13 and 15 with information.

1st Supervisor: Town Hall Rental: 6 rentals in May; 8 in June. Park Rental 1 in May and 1 in June. BCBCM joined together. Cyrus bought building. Cyrus to run Center in Cochrane. Town of Buffalo possible served by Cyrus. Town of Buffalo is 1st in recycling for the County. Flyway Trail met. Ball field in Park is being used.

2nd Supervisor: Baures' bill was gone over. Culvert next to Oak Lane is blocked. Goes under County Road P. Could be a County issue. There is some storm damage on Gold Street- tree down Sikorski, Oak Lane, Castle Rock and Chicken Valley.

Clerk: Waiting for final information from Auditor. CT report has been filed. Liquor Licenses have been sent out. Next election to be held August 9th Partisan primary.
