

POSTPONED REGULAR MEETING, TUESDAY, DECEMBER 6, 2022 7:00 P.M.-TOWN HALL

The Regular meeting of the Town of Buffalo Board was called to order by Chairman Steve James. Roll call: Drazkowski, Waters, Bittner, Strom. Citizens: Bob Baures, Gordon Albrecht, Dennis Waters, Dan Rolbiecki, Jason Marin, Jim Burfiend. The meeting was held as noticed. Motion Waters, second Drazkowski to approve minutes from October 25, 2022 Regular Meeting. All yes, motion carried.

Treasurer's Report: Balance of November 3, 2022: \$28,997.28. Balance as of November 27, 2022: \$55,332.98. Shared Revenue of \$30,604.26 received. Financial Statement gone over. Bills were read. Motion Drazkowski, second Waters to accept treasurer's report and pay bills. All yes, motion carried.

Chair: A change in the 2023 Budget to set aside \$5000 for future furnace that will be needed for the Town Hall. 2023 Budget is set for \$291,512. Motion Waters, second Drazkowski to approve 2023 Budget of \$291,512. All yes, motion carried. Several tires were dropped off at the Recycling Center. Checking into where to get rid of them. Fleet Farm charges \$5 a tire. A new updated Municipal Guide for 2022-2023 with a list of officers for all municipalities is available. County is questioning Ready Mix bill of \$5000. Project was for Brandhorst Road. Four loads of concrete to hold rip rap in place by culverts. County also questioned about duplication of bills from Baures. Need to call a road meeting with Baures. Spur Lane has a parking ordinance violation. Discussion of alternate side parking, parking on the highway side so plow can get to the mailboxes. Needs sand on Spur Lane past Gibbons. Highway Encroachment Violations (Statute 86.04(1)) fences on the right of way. Discussion to grandfather in what is there, if there is new construction, if a problem occurs what to do about it, or not do anything about it at this time. Distinguished Service Recognition of 14 years of more to be displayed in the Town Hall on a plaque. No new updates on Broadband Project.

1st Supervisor: Town Hall Rental: 51 rentals in the year 2022; 3 in December and 3 requests for 2023 already. December 12, 2022 carpets will be cleaned. Dumpster in park will be locked and out of service for the winter. BCB&M (Waste Transport) will pick up and turn into County.

2nd Supervisor: Baures' bill was gone over. Sign at intersection by Alliance Bank is not working. Discussion of replacing with a yield sign instead. Clerk to order a yield sign. Need to go over Baures bill with Milestone materials and pull the County Joint projects out.

Clerk: General Election held November 8, 2022 went well with turn out around 300 voters. Motion Drazkowski, second Waters to approve Millrate worksheet for 2022 taxes. All yes, motion carried. Collection dates are set for December 31, 2022 and January 28, 2023 from 9am to 1 pm. Taxes are here and waiting for brochures and dog license forms to be mailed out. Motion Waters, second Drazkowski to approve operator's license for the bartenders. All yes, motion carried.

Jason Marin is concerned that the school bus will not come back on Spur Lane because Foundations Chiropractor refuses to allow the bus on the road by them.

Need to contact County to place school bus stop signs by Dan Koblacki House.

Next Regular meeting to be held December 20, 2022 at 7:00 pm.

CAPX Committee meeting will be held in January 2023.

Motion Waters, second Drazkowski to adjourn the meeting. All yes, motion carried. Meeting was adjourned at 8:19 pm.
